- Your ticket remains the property of Limitless and is a personal revocable license which may be withdrawn, and admission refused at any time upon refunding the printed purchase price. Any unacceptable behaviour likely to cause damage, nuisance or injury shall entitle Limitless or the owners of the venue to eject you from the event.
- In some locations, tickets may be exchanged for wristbands to allow access to the event.
 Wristband passes will be available for collection on arrival at Limitless ONE. Where group bookings have been made, passes may only be collected by the group leader or other designated person. Passes will only be supplied on receipt of your tickets or booking confirmation.

 Limitless, or any agent acting on their behalf, accepts no responsibility for any personal property, the general care, travel and accommodation arrangements for delegates except that which is implied by the aims or terms and conditions of the event.
- 5) Limitless reserves the right to cancel bookings which it reasonably suspects to have been made fraudulently.

- 7) It is your responsibility to check your booking; mistakes cannot always be rectified at a later date.
- 8) It is the responsibility of the customer to inform Limitless of any change of address, contact phone number or email address after booking. Please note that our preferred method of contact about guest bookings is by email, so care should be taken to provide a current, valid email address.
- 9) Once purchased, tickets will only be refunded in extenuating circumstances. The decision of Limitless regarding what will be considered as extenuating circumstances will be final. Should a ticket holder wish to seek a refund they should notify Limitless events at <u>events@limitlesselim.co.uk</u> in writing immediately. The date of receipt will be the date on which any refunds are based. Please note that Limitless booking office will confirm they have received your request for cancellation. Should you not receive confirmation, this will mean that your email or letter has not been received and therefore you will not be entitled to any refund.

 After 1st February No refunds available
- 11) The following are not considered extenuating circumstances:
 - a) A group books before they have confirmation of who is coming in the hope that they would fill the spaces, and now is unable to do so.
 - b) A young person said they were coming and then could not because:
 - i) their parents wouldn't let them
 - ii) they could not get the time off work
 - iii) they have too much exam revision or homework
 - iv) minor illness
 - v) accommodation/travel being hindered as a result of breakdown or adverse weather.

Groups may wish to seek insurance cover for such eventualities.

- 12) While we try and ensure that all prices on our website are accurate, errors may occur. If we discover an error in the price of the tickets you have ordered, we will inform you as soon as possible and give you the option of reconfirming your order at the correct price (and credit or debit your account as applicable) or cancelling your order. If we are unable to contact you, you agree that we may treat the order as cancelled. If you choose to cancel after you have already paid the incorrect ticket price for the tickets, you will receive a full refund from us.
- 13) If paying by bank transfer, payment must be made within 14 days of invoice. Limitless reserves the right to charge interest at the standard rate (currently 8% + Bank of England base rate).
 If you have made advantage of an early-bird price discount or discount code, full payment must be made before the end of the price break. If full payment is not made, any remaining unpaid tickets will incur the increased cost of the tickets.
- 14) Should the event be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances ticket holders will be offered tickets at a rescheduled event (subject to availability) up to the face value of the tickets or if the ticket holder is unable to attend the rescheduled event or the event is not rescheduled, a refund. Refunds for tickets purchased prior to the date of the original event will be given up to their face value.
